- HTM 06-03 safety rules and procedures.
- High voltage equipment including switchgear and transformers.
- Substation operation and maintenance.
- High Voltage (HV) distribution systems, ring and radial system operation.
- High Voltage (HV) protection including: HRC fuses, time limit fuses and common relays.
- Completion of records and documentation including: Permits to Work, sanctions for test and limitations of access.
- Identification and location of cables.
- High Voltage Distribution System Grading.
- Testing/commissioning of High Voltage (HV) electrical distribution equipment.
- Authorised Person (HVAP) roles and responsibilities.

The course concludes with a personal assessment and from this our training consultants will produce an individual pathway to sure continuous Authorised Person (AP) appointment. The pathway document will be sent to the delegate's Authorising Engineer (AE).

- Improved communication, documentation and enforcement of safe working procedures in line with HTM 06-03.
