- Practical exercises designed to reinforce understanding.

The course concludes with a personal assessment of each delegate and from this, our training consultants will produce an Individual pathway to achieve and maintain Authorised Person Authorisation. This document will be sent to the delegate's Authorising Engineer (AE).
